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## Administrative history / Biographical sketch

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### Note

Julia Cecilia Moore was born on November 30, 1911, to Francis (Frank) Joseph Moore (d. 1938) and Julia Camilla Coughlin (d. 1965) in St. Thomas, Ontario. Active in the St. Thomas community growing up, Cecilia was a summer lifeguard at Alma College Pool, and served as recreational director at her alma mater, St. Joseph's High School, during her college years in the 1930's. Having obtained an Honours Bachelor of Arts Degree in History and French from the University of Western Ontario, Cecilia went on to obtain a high school assistant certificate in English and History from the Ontario College of Education in Toronto. Cecilia entered the congregation in London, Ontario in 1935 at Sacred Heart Convent and received the habit and religious name of Sister Julia on August 25th, 1936. She professed her first vows on August 25th, 1938, and her final vows on August 25th, 1941 in the Chapel of Sacred Heart Convent. Sister Julia began teaching at St. Michael's School in London, with teaching assignments at Roman Catholic high schools in St. Thomas and Sarnia, during which time she completed a Master of Arts Degree in French at Laval University. She eventually became the principal at Catholic Central High School in London. After two years as a principal, Sister Julia was elected General Superior in 1959. She held the position until 1971, then served four years as a General Councillor.

Her leadership had an impact on many aspects of the Sisters of St. Joseph's involvement in education, health care, social work, retreat work and missions in Peru and Northern Canada. Mother Julia was also named Health Care Coordinator of the community, serving five hospitals and two chronic care hospitals. She was the Superior of the community of Sisters at St. Joseph's Hospital, and a member of the pastoral care team, during which time she studied theology and scripture during a sabbatical year at Regina Mundi College in Rome. In 1979, Mother Julia returned to Mount St. Joseph where she directed retreats, and served as a spiritual director as well as a historian for the Congregation, and a consultant for the archives department. Mother Julia's work, *Beginnings in London Diocese 1868-1879*, was presented to the

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Canadian Catholic Historical Society in 1978 and published by the London Roman Catholic School Board. Mother Julia died on October 5th, 1995.

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## Scope and content

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The sous-fonds contains the personal and business records of Mother Julia Moore. This includes personal and business correspondence, primarily from her tenure as General Superior; biographical records and photographs; her work, \*Beginnings in London Diocese 1868-1879\*; photographs and a diary from her trip to Italy and France; records from her trip to Ireland as part of the Ireland project; photographs and an account from her time in Peru; watercolour artwork gifted by Sister Mary Celine Janisse; photographs of the Pope and Papal mass; a yarmulke and photographs from the bar mitzvah of Irwin Zaifman; her speeches; her historical research, predominantly on the Sisters of St. Joseph; pamphlets and articles collected by Mother Julia Moore, notably of Pierre Wolff, S. J.'s works; information and documents pertaining to the International Union of Superiors General (U.I.S.G.); photographs and correspondence from the International Union of Mothers' General meeting in 1969; a souvenir booklet from Pope John Paul II's 1984 visit to Toronto, Canada; and a feast day book about the founder of the Congregation of the Sisters of St. Joseph of London, Reverend Jean Pierre Médaille. There is also material concerning the 2005 Lyon heritage display.

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### Title notes

- **Source of title proper:** Title is based on the name of the contents of the sous-fonds.

### Immediate source of acquisition

The records were transferred to the archives from Mother Julia Moore's personal custody upon her death.

### Arrangement

Original order was maintained.

### Location of originals

The records are located at The Congregation of the Sisters of St. Joseph in Canada Archives.

### Restrictions on access

This sous-fonds is restricted to public access until 2025.

Scope and content: This series consists of historical research conducted by Mother Julia Moore. Material includes research material, pamphlets, magazines, clippings, notes, correspondence, and drafts of writings. The topics covered include general histories and timelines, histories of the Federation of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Canada, histories of the congregation in London, histories of Sisters in Western Canada, history of the Canadian Medaille Team (a congregation wide study group dedicated to the translation and study of the primitive constitutions, spiritual life and observances), history and symbology of the coat of arms; histories of the Sisters in Peru, histories of the community institutions run by the Sisters in London, and house histories (institutions and residences of the Sisters of St. Joseph) from across Canada. Her research primarily covers the late 1800's to the late 1900's. Material of note includes research for, drafts, and published versions of \*Beginnings in London Diocese 1868-1878\* by Mother Julia Moore; a photocopy of \*Frontiers and Foundations 1851-1985\*; Alice Mulvey's unpublished article "A 20th Century Haven" which summarizes the history of Marian Villa in London, Ontario; correspondence concerning the Post-Conciliar Commission; \*Centre Report\* Volume 4, Issue 15 (July 20, 1989), a publication by St. Joseph's Health Centre of London; a photocopy of the pamphlet for the Sisters of St. Joseph Federation International's 150th anniversary event in 1989; pamphlets from the Sisters of St. Joseph in Canada Federation's 135th anniversary event in Toronto, 1989; material from the workshop for congregational archivists held in Missouri in 1985; and material from Summer Institute 1975, an event organized by the Federation of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Canada to gather, share, and present their research, including notes, itineraries and outlines of a lecture on Jean Pierre Médaille.
