UNITED CHURCH OF CANADA BOARD OF INFORMATION AND STEWARDSHIP FONDS. – 1953-1973, PREDOMINANT 1954-1968. – 8 m of textual records. – 21 photographs. --17 audio tape reels. --7 audio cassettes.

The Board of Information and Stewardship was authorized by General Council in 1954 to gather together the literature services of several different Boards and committees, the publicity activities of the Church, the production of audio-visual services, and the education for mission's activity. To coordinate these Departments there were Directors of Audio-Visual Services, Broadcasting, and Press and Information, and an Editor of Missionary Education Publications. The cooperative nature of the Board can be seen in its membership: along with a Chairman, Secretary, Associate Secretary and Assistant Secretaries, there were to be representatives of fifteen United Church Boards, societies and publications. The Executive Committee was designed in much the same manner. The Board also enjoyed relations with Conferences, usually through the Conference Communications Committees, Conference and regional literature distribution depots, and regional broadcasting centres. At the centre of the new Board was the creation and activity of Berkeley Studio which opened in 1956. Here were produced the photographs, film and filmstrips, recordings and radio and television productions that promoted the work of the United Church. In 1966 the Christian stewardship function was removed and consolidated with the Missionary and Maintenance Department of the Board of Finance and the name changed to Board of Information. The Board was disbanded in 1968; most of its responsibilities and staff were transferred to the new Division of Communication.

Fonds consists of five series: records of meetings and of the Board Executive, 1954-1968; records of the Department of Audio Visual Services, 1949-1970; records of the Department of Broadcasting, 1955-1973; records of the Department of Press and Information, 1960-1968; and records of the Department of Missionary Education, 1957-1962.

Before copies are made of any radio programmes originating from the United Church of Canada, all existing authors' or actors' rights must be investigated.

SERIES 1: RECORDS OF MEETING AND OF THE BOARD EXECUTIVE. – 1954-1968. 1.6 m of textual records.

The Board held annual meetings at which reports from the Secretaries and Directors were submitted. In addition regular meetings of the Board Executive were attended by senior personnel as well as representatives of several of the Church Boards. Several committees of the Board responsible for the oversight of its activities were chaired by the Secretary or Associate Secretary. Herbert Pottle served as Secretary, 1954-1963; and Charles M. Stewart served as Associate Secretary, 1954-1963 and as Secretary, 1963-1967.

Series consists of minutes of Annual Meetings, 1955-1967; minutes of the Executive, 1956-1967 (incomplete); Annual Reports of the Board, 1956-1964; minutes and reports, agendas, and background materials of Board committees for which Secretaries had responsibility, including the Communications Standing Committee, Communications Survey Committee, Committee on Information and Public Relations, various committees on literature distribution, Stewardship Committee, Mission Education Committee, and Committee of Liaison with the Woman's Missionary Society, 1956-1967; correspondence with the General Council and Boards, 1955-1965; correspondence with Conferences and Presbyteries, 1956-1966; correspondence files with Board staff on subjects including Berkeley Studio, staff appointments, interdenominational broadcasting, 1957-1968; general correspondence files, 1957-1964; correspondence, financial and annual reports relating to the Literature Distribution Centre and regional depots, 1954-1966; a series of general files organized on a subject basis and arranged alphabetically, 1955-1965; financial documents including budgets, 1955-1965; and files related to general Board activities, including its constitution and amalgamation into the Division of Communication.

These files contain correspondence with the Moderator; the Secretary of General Council; Secretaries of Boards and church organisations, including the Woman's Missionary Society, the Board of Men, the Pensions Department, the Board of Publications and the Missionary and Maintenance Department; and with the chairman and members of the Board of Information and Stewardship. Files 4/17-19, 26 also include some correspondence with conveners of Conference Information and Stewardship Committees.

The correspondence relates to the formation and functions of the Board of Information and Stewardship, liaison with other boards, nomination of officers, policy on radio and television, public relations, the Literature Distribution Services, United Church House, personnel matters and topical affairs such as mainland China and communism.

CORRESPONDENCE WITH CONFERENCES AND PRESBYTERIES, 1956-1966

These files contain correspondence with the conveners of Conference and Presbytery Information and Stewardship committees, along with circular letters sent by the Board to conveners. They also include some copies of the reports made by the conveners to their Conference or Presbytery.

The correspondence relates to the representation of Information and Stewardship at Conference, Presbytery and Congregational levels and the structural organisation of committees; the appointment of full-time Conference broadcasting personnel and audio-visual counsellors; arrangements for workshops and consultations of conveners; and special projects.

The files are arranged by Conference. The general files include correspondence with several Conferences or Presbyteries.

CORRESPONDENCE WITH STAFF, 1957-1968

These files contain correspondence with the directors and assistant directors and other staff of the Board, including memos and reports, along with correspondence of Board of Information and Stewardship staff with external organisations copied to the Secretaries for their information. They also contain some circulars and other supporting material.

The subject matter of the files includes communications workshops and resources; Berkeley Studio opening; Berkeley Studio equipment and expenses; staff appointments and staffing structure of Conferences programme outlines and broadcasting research; sponsorship of broadcasts and programmes; interdenominational broadcasting; an audio-visual department visit to Angola and subsequent productions, and personnel matters.

The files are arranged by department. Berkeley Studio files contain material from both the Audio-Visual and Broadcasting Departments.

LITERATURE DISTRIBUTION CENTRE AND REGIONAL DEPOTS, 1954-1966

The Literature Distribution Centre was established in 1956 on the authority of the Executive of General Council.¹ It was administered by the Board of Information and Stewardship but produced a service to various Boards and organisations of the United Church. The Centre was located in the Wesley Buildings and staffed by a Business Manager with an assistant. The Board of Publication operated its own distribution service through the Mail Order and Retail Services of the United Church Publishing House until 1967 when the two services were merged as the Distribution Services of the United Church Publishing House.²

Regional Depots were established at the request of Conferences and were funded jointly by the Conference and the participating Boards. They also received discounts on materials sent from the Literature Distribution Centre.³ The Board of Information and Stewardship was responsible for liaison between the Regional Depots and the Literature Distribution Centre and remained so after the 1967 merger of distribution services under the Board of Publication. When the Board of Information was disbanded in 1968, Regional Depots became the responsibility of the Committee on Education for Mission and Stewardship in the Division of Congregational Life and Work. Therefore, the Regional Depots received subsidies from the Division of Congregational Life and Work, but reported to the Division of Communication and paid their bills to the Ryerson Press.

These files contain financial and annual reports, budgets, correspondence with the Literature Distribution Centre manager, and with the manager of the Regional Depots and the Conference conveners, along with reports and copy minutes.

SERIES 2: RECORDS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF AUDIO-VISUAL SERVICES. – 1940-1970 PREDOMINANT 1954-1968. – 72 cm of textual records. – 4 photograph albums.

This Department served the interests of missionary education and stewardship, as well as those of the participating Boards. It was responsible for film, filmstrip, and photographic production. The Department had the added responsibility of training ministers in the use of audio-visual resources. For much of the period, Anson Moorhouse served as Director. Between 1964 and 1967 the Department reported to the annual meeting as the Department of Instructional Communication.

Series consists largely of the records of the Director and Assistant Directors, including minutes of committees, 1955-1957; similar records for films, 1965-1970; production files, including research material, correspondence, news clippings, interview transcripts and notes relating to the production of films, 1949-1967; workshop files relating to the uses and techniques of audio-visual materials by Church workers, 1961-1968; and general subject files, containing correspondence, articles, questionnaires, reports, and circulars regarding research into audio-visual usage within the Church, policy matters, and Departmental administration.

PRODUCTIONS, 1949-1967

These files contain research material, correspondence, articles, transcripts of interviews and notes relating to proposed audio-visual filmstrips or films. In the main, this is preliminary background research for audio-visual production. Some of the material resulted in several productions in connection with a missionary education or stewardship theme.

Two files pre-date the establishment of the Board of Information and Stewardship (18/10,11) and one of these (18/11) includes correspondence between Anson Moorhouse and Herbert Pottle, then Minister of Public Welfare, Newfoundland, and later Secretary to the Board of Information and Stewardship.

These files were numbered at some point after 1967 but it is not clear whether these former references were used by the Audio-Visual Department or by the Division of Communication.

WORKSHOPS, 1961-1968

Workshops in audio-visual techniques and in communication skills were provided by the Audio-Visual Department, often in co-operation with the Press and the Broadcasting Departments, for Conferences and Presbytery Counsellors, for ministers, for theological students and for other interested groups. Some workshops were held in Toronto at Berkeley Studio, but many were held in centres across Canada to enable local access. The workshops were intended to inform participants about the range of materials available and train them in the use of materials and equipment. [See also 34-37: Broadcasting Department Workshop]

These files contain correspondence with participants and host Conferences, Presbyteries or congregations, along with leaflets, circulars and materials used during the workshops and reports in the workshops. The former references are of unknown origin. The files are arranged in chronological order.

<u>SERIES 3: RECORDS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF BROADCASTING. – 1955-1973, PREDOMINANT</u> <u>1955-1968. – 4 m of textual records. – 17 audio tape reels. – 7 audio cassettes. – 21hotographs.</u>

The Broadcasting Department (originally Radio and Television Department, 1954-1961), was responsible for radio and television production and broadcasting, and was charged with the responsibility of fostering and encouraging the wider use of the media for the spread of the Christian gospel. It was to develop programming to appeal to target audiences based on age, with productions from Berkeley Studio in Toronto, as well as with regional and local initiatives, such as Local Live Television. In addition, it was responsible for coverage of General Councils. Radio programmes included: "Between Ourselves" and "City Mike," in Toronto, and "Tell Us a Story," "When a Child Asks," and "Good News," nationally. The western Conferences produced "Encounter." Television programmes included: "Spectrum," an interfaith programme on the Toronto station CFTO-TV; "Trail Tales," "Secret World" and "Hi-Time," for young people. The Department also promoted links with other denominations, and with bodies outside Canada like the broadcasting wing of the National Council of Churches of Christ (U.S.A.). Keith Woollard was Director for most of this period.

Series consists of minutes of the Radio and Television Committee, 1955-1957; correspondence with sponsoring Church Boards, 1956-1960; correspondence with Conference Communications Committees concerning regional staffing, production, and programme scheduling, 1962-1967; staff correspondence, 1963-1967; general correspondence with external bodies and individuals, including script writers and

musicians, re programming, 1956-1967; programme correspondence, scripts, evaluations, cost sheets, programme outlines, promotional material of individual programmes, (including for example, Checkpoint including audio-tapes, Christmas and Easter broadcasts, Just a Minute, On the Spot, When a Child Asks, Women's Broadcasts, General Council coverage, and the Spectrum television), 1955-1969; Local Live Television files, 1959-1966; workshop files, 1958-1969; policy and administration files, 1955-1967; records, including minutes, of committees in which the Directors had membership--within the Board, of General Council, and of other Church and interdenominational bodies, 1955-1968; financial records, including budgets, 1955-1967; and general subject files, including, for example, files re the Broadcasting Research Project, 1961-1964, investigating the viewing habits of children.

All tapes of 'Checkpoint' are considered preservation copies and are not available to researchers until the information on the tapes has been transferred to a separate medium.

Re-broadcast and copying of all radio programmes is not permitted without the written permission of the Division of Communication, United Church of Canada.

Before copies are made of any radio programmes originating from the United Church of Canada, all existing authors' or actors' rights must be investigated.

PROGRAMMES, 1955-1969

The main function of the broadcasting Department was the production, distribution and promotion of radio and television programmes. Many of the programmes originated with Berkeley Studio staff, in response to perceived gaps: the provision of religious broadcasts, and some were produced at the request of United Church boards or committees. The Broadcasting staff also provided coverage of major United Church events, in particular meetings of General Council. Other programmes were produced in co-operation with commercial or ecumenical broadcasting companies or bought from broadcasting companies in the United States or the United Kingdom. One major co-operative routine was the Spectrum series of programmes jointly produced by the Anglican, Roman Catholic and United Church through their co-operative television production units, Religious Television Associates. Another major project was local Live Television, which was launched by the 1958 General Council to encourage local, live religions programmes. The local programmes were based on the <u>Talkback</u> television series, where a short film on a problem situation provided the basis for a live discussion.

These files contain correspondence, scripts, transcripts of discussions, script evaluations, cost sheets, programme outlines, programme proposals, promotional material, and policy papers. The material relates to all aspects of the production distribution and promotion of the programmes.

Files relating to individual programmes or series are organized alphabetically. These are followed by files relating to coverage of General Council meetings, and the Spectrum series in chronological order;

and Local Live Television in alphabetical order. Files relating to more then one programme are listed at the end of this series in chronological order.

CHECKPOINT

"Checkpoint" was a radio programme jointly produced by the Anglican and United Churches in the years 1965-1967. It was a fifteen-minute current affairs programme that promoted the views of the church on contemporary social issues. In the holdings there are two sets of tape designations: The 'PN' designations are tapes that can be tied to a programme number (pn) in the Programme description lists found in file 2-1 - these apply only to audio tape reels. The 'B' designations are listed in the same file, without dates, the 'b' designating that the tapes were distributed from Berkeley Studio, and this began with the year 1966 (see 'Keith Wollard to Peter [Meggs] 23 December, 1965', file 2-1). All 'b' designations are audio cassettes.

WORKSHOPS, 1958-1969

Workshops in broadcasting and communications were provided by the Broadcasting Department, often in co-operation with the Press and the Audio-Visual Departments, for Conference and Presbytery communications committee conveners, for ministers, for theological students and for other interested persons. [See also 19/3-29; Audio-Visual Workshops.] Broadcasting staff also arranged workshops for a number of external organisations with no church affiliation or provided components of workshops, courses and seminars arranged by other broadcasting groups. The staff also attended courses and seminars as participants for their own professional development.

This file series consists of files on workshops provided by the Broadcasting Department for church personnel and other interested people; and files on courses, seminars and workshops arranged by other organisations.

The files contain correspondence, schedules and resource material. Files relating to workshops provided for churches and church personnel are listed chronologically. POLICY AND ADMINISTRATION, 1955-1967

GENERAL, 1955-1973

This file series consists of the remaining subject files created by members of the Broadcasting Department. The subjects reflect some of the work the staff carried out in addition to their production responsibilities. There are a numbers of reference files as well as files relating to membership of external groups and activities outside Berkeley Studio. Included are three subjects which generated a number of files.

The Broadcasting Research Project was a study of the viewing habits and interests of children between the ages 9 and 11 undertaken for Berkeley Studio with regard to the pre-teen series, <u>Secret World</u>.

The Broadcasting and Film Commission (B.F.C.) was an arm of the National Council of the B.F.C. during the period documented by this collection. The Director of Broadcasting, Keith Woollard, represented the United Church of Canada and was for a time a member of the Board of Managers and served on various committees. The files have been weeded of annual reports and published material, and only material relating to the participation of the United Church in the B.F.C. has been retained. Most of the files include material accumulated after the Board of Information and Stewardship was disbanded and the broadcasting responsibilities devoted to the Division of Communication.

The World Association for Christian Broadcasting (WACB) emerged out of the World Committee for Christian Broadcasting in 1902. Keith Woollard, the Director of Broadcasting, was a member of the Provisional Committee of the WACB and of the North American Section of the WACB, representing the United Church of Canada. SERIES 5: RECORDS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MISSIONARY EDUCATION. – 1955-1966. – 14 cm of textual records

The missionary education function of the Board was transferred in 1955 from the Committee on Missionary Education. Priorities were set for mission education work in cooperation with the Church's mission Boards and served as the main channel for the promotion of missions through study materials, publications, and publicity. Charles M. Stewart, as Associate Secretary of the Board, had special responsibility for missionary education. The committee which oversaw this function in the Board was called the Committee on Missionary Education until 1962, and subsequently the Committee on Mission Education. Missionary education was transferred to the new Division of Congregational Life and Work in 1966.

Series consists of minutes of the Committee on Missionary Education/Mission Education, and various subcommittees (including those regarding children, teenagers, and adults), 1955-1966; and general files of the Editor of Missionary Education Publications, including proposed biographies of prominent United Church members as well as notes and scripts for plays.
