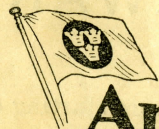

CONDITIONS OF FORWARDING.

Should the steamer, for some reason or other, be prevented from starting on its voyage or to continue voyage once commenced, the passengers may be transferred at the expense of the Company to another steamer for conveyance to their destination.

The Company does not hold itself liable for any loss or damage to the passenger, his baggage, or personal effects in the event of force majeure, arrest or measures taken by the authorities, strikes or lock-outs, collision, stranding or any other sea accident, fire on board, explosion, breakage of shaft, or any other accident on board or other error, even if such accident may be considered as caused by an error of navigation by the ship's officers, crew, pilots, or others employed on board the ship, defect of the ship itself, its machinery or outfit.

The Company shall not be responsible for loss or injury to passengers baggage for amount exceeding Kr. 50:— for each adult, children half, and only for baggage, which is properly checked and has remained in the Company's charge throughout the voyage.

Claims for lost or injured baggage must be made to the office onboard within 24 hours of landing; later claims can not be considered.

The passenger is not supposed to pay or entitled to receive part of any general contribution for his baggage or personal effects.

If the passenger does not in ample time before departure give notice that he is unable to sail as intended, the ticket is to be considered forfeited and no claim for refund of fare paid or part thereof will be considered.
