

## **BY-LAW NO. 59.**

### **A BY-LAW RELATING TO DOGS.**

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF COPPER CLIFF, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:—

1.—That By-Law No. 6 be and the same is hereby repealed.

2.—In this By-Law the word “dog” shall include bitch unless a contrary intention appears.

3.—Any dog known to be rabid shall be immediately destroyed, and any Police Constable or other person is authorized to destroy the same.

4.—No owner of any bitch shall suffer the same to run or be at large while in heat.

5.—If any dog shall attack any person in any street or highway of the said Town, or shall do any damage or shall by barking, biting, howling or in any other way or manner disturb the quiet of any person or persons and complaint thereof shall be made to the Police Magistrate or Mayor, in the absence of the Police Magistrate he shall inquire into the complaint, and if satisfied that such complaint is substantiated shall order the owner of such dog to remove the same permanently out of the Town, or to deliver the same over to the Consta

ble of the said Town in order that it may be destroyed and the owner of such dog shall in accordance with any such order within the space of twenty-four hours after having received notice thereof either remove permanently such dog beyond the limits of the said Town or cause the same to be delivered to the Chief or such other Constable to be destroyed, and any person disobeying such order shall be guilty of an offence against the provisions of this By Law.

6 — Any person offending against the provisions of this By Law shall, upon conviction thereof before any Justice of the Peace or Police Magistrate forfeit any pay such sum not less than one dollar or more than fifty dollars as such Justice or Police Magistrate shall order, and costs, and if not forthwith paid the same shall be levied by distress, and sa'e of the goods and chatte's of the offender, and in case of non-payment of such fine and costs, and in case of there being no distress found out of which the penalty can be levied, it shall and may be lawful for such Justice or Police Magistrate to commit the offender to the Common Gaol of the District of Sudbury for such term not exceeding twenty one days with or without hard labor as he shall see fit.

BY-LAW NO. 52.

A BY-LAW RELATING TO DUES.

The following are the provisions of the By-Law relating to Dues:

1. That the Law No. 52, and the same is hereby amended.
2. In the Law No. 52, the word "and" shall be inserted after the word "and" in the second line of the first section.
3. Any member who fails to pay his dues for a period of three months shall be considered as having resigned from the Society.
4. The amount of arrears due from any member shall be paid in full at once.
5. The Society shall have the right to suspend any member who fails to pay his dues for a period of three months.
